

Resolving AeroDrive Super One Click Error

1. Please upgrade to AeroDrive Super One Click v.7.84x (http://www.aerodrive.com/super_7_84x.exe) as the new version will detect whether "AeroDrive_Super_Service" is running. If not, it will attempt to start it. However, in order to start background service, admin right is required. If you do not have admin right, you may have to ask someone with admin right to proceed.
2. When encounter "Can not connect named pipe" in AeroDrive Super One Click v.7.83x, normally it mean "AeroDrive_Super_Service" is not automatically started upon reboot.
3. Or if you're running a version older than v.7,83, chances are also that it is the "AeroDrive_Super_Service" is not running.
4. Normally it happen after windows update for unknown reasons. But reboot again will normally resolve the problem.
5. If still encounter error, please try to start "AeroDrive_Super_Service" in "Service App"
6. As "AeroDrive_Super_Service" is dependent on "Workstation" Service, please make sure "Workstation" is started and set to "Automatic" in Service properties
